

RULES OF ENTRY

By entering any event you are confirming to abide by the rules of entry. All communication should be sent to: events@warehillequestrian.co.uk

1 SAFETY

- 1.1 At all events riders shall wear hats in accordance with the current safety requirements. They must be in good condition and correctly fitted.
- 1.2 Proper footwear and jackets must be worn at all events.
- 1.3 Horses and ponies are permitted for walking only on the show ground.
- 1.4 Horses must not be ridden unless correctly and fully tacked up.
- 1.5 No horse or pony under 4 years old to be ridden on the show ground.
- 1.6 Stallions and colts are to be bitted on the show ground and handled/ridden by someone 14 years or over.
- 1.7 All horses/ponies must be flu vaccinated. Vaccination certificates may be asked for at random.
- 1.8 No more than 5 competitors can use the warm up arena at the same time.
- 1.9 No entries will be accepted for children under the age of 5 years old for competing.
- 1.10 Parents/carers must ensure young children are adequately supervised at all times.
- 1.11 Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and mess must be cleaned up
- 1.12 No glass bottles or containers are to be brought onto the showground.
- 1.13 Lorries and trailers must be parked considerably in the lorry park.
- 1.14 Limited car parking is available outside the showground on a first come, first served basis and parked appropriately to allow lorries and trailers access to enter the showground.

2 GENERAL

- 2.1 Hay is only permitted outside lorries or trailers in the designated lorry park but strictly no hay outside of lorries or trailers on the show ground.
- 2.2 Please take your litter home. No mucking out of vehicles on the Showground.
- 2.3 Please ensure any qualifier registration forms are given to the show secretary prior to entering the class, confirmation after the class/event cannot be accepted.
- 2.4 Competitors entering show jumping Class 1 are prevented from entering Class 4 unless HC in one or the other.
- 2.5 Competitors entering Dressage Class 1 or 2 and prevented from entering Class 4 unless HC in one or the other.

3 CONDUCT

- 3.1 Competitors shall conduct themselves in a responsible manner at all times.
- 3.2 Excessive use of whips/spurs will result in elimination. Whips must not be longer than 30 inches.

4 JUDGES DECISION AND OBJECTIONS

- 4.1 The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without stating the reason for doing so and can cancel or amalgamate any classes if the entries justify this course of action.
- 4.2 Judges have the right to query any entrant's qualifications to enter a class e.g. height of pony, age of rider, previous experience etc.
- 4.3 Officials and competitors only are permitted in the show ring.
- 4.4 Only horses/ponies competing at the show may be ridden at the centre.
- 4.5 The decision of the judge is, in every case, final. No objection may be made directly to a judge. Objections must be made in writing to the secretary within 30 minutes of completion of the judging of the class concerned. All objections to be accompanied by a deposit of £10.00. This fee is refundable should the objection be sustained.

5 RESPONSIBILITY

- 5.1 Persons participating in or attending any event do so at their own risk.
- 5.2 It a condition of entry that competitors agree to abide by the competition rules.
- 5.3 The organisers and their helpers are not responsible for any injury to any participant, spectator, or horse, or for any loss or damage of any vehicle, trailer or equipment brought onto the show ground or parking area.
- 5.4 The exhibitor of any animal shall indemnify and hold harmless the centre and its committee from and against actions, suits, expenses and claims on account or in respect of any damage or injury caused or occasioned.

6 ENTRY, PAYMENT AND REFUNDS

- 6.1 Refunds or transfers will not be honoured once entries have closed and orders processed for individual classes or the event.
- 6.2 Refunds may be given on the production of a vet's certificate or upon notification to the show secretary prior to the closing date of the event.
- 6.3 An administration charge of £3.00 per entry may be levied for transfers or refunds honoured.
