



COVID GUIDANCE 28022021

Please do not come to the centre if you have; a high temperature of over 37.8 degrees; a new continuous cough; loss or change to your sense of smell or taste. Stay at home. Do not travel. Check the latest guidance to book a test at: www.nhs.uk/coronavirus

Public or group spectating is currently not permitted, a driver/groom and/or a parent/carer are permitted to support competitors. Please bring your own hand sanitiser to use regularly during your visit to the centre and keep to social distancing. Where 2m distance is not possible the wearing of face covering is advised.

On arrival, please make your way to the parking area at the top of the arena for trailers and park considerately. Parking on the showground is only available for large lorries. **Competitors must notify the show secretary on arrival and declare entry.** Cars are not permitted on the showground and must park at the entrance, subject to availability as space is limited.

Competitors will be permitted to enter the warm-up arena. A maximum of 4 will be allowed at one time, no other member of the public will be permitted to enter the warm-up arena. Competitors must ensure they make their way to the outdoor arena for the start of the class and enter the arena to the left.

To reduce the risk from cash handling, there will be no opportunity to enter additional classes on the day unless agreed with the show secretary in advance of the class and instant payment via PayPal made.

Refreshments will be available on the day offering take away food and drink. When collecting refreshments, you must ensure you comply with social distancing measures. Toilet facilities will be available for use; please ensure you wash/sanitise your hands when entering and exiting the facilities.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without refund on the day should measures not be complied with.
